When the underground caves were rediscovered in 1950, their location, identified as being proximity to Caiaphas palace, and their contiguity with the Sacra Via (in its course) all suggested the public jail where, according to a 19th-century Greek tradition not recorded in the gospels, Jesus would have been scourged on the way by Pilate but also by Caiaphas, and where the apostles Peter and John would have been held and scourged for preaching the name of Jesus in the temple area after the resurrection (Acts 5:19-42).

Added to the context, Christians traditionally recall here some of the painful sufferings sustained by Jesus during his Passion, regardless of where they took place, as well as by the apostles, the first believers in his name.
